CCA Policies

- **Every student will be assigned 1 CCA**
- **Every student is encouraged to stay committed to his/her CCA for 4 to 5 years.**
- **Attain 75% and above for CCA attendance annually.**



Management of absentees:

- Absent from CCA: produce either MC or a letter from their parents (only 3 parent's letters are allowed for the whole year).

| Absent without Reason | Course of Action |

| 1st time | Parents informed |
| 2nd time | Warning letter issued to student and parents informed |
| 3rd time | Student and Parent to meet HOD PE/CCA (Further actions will be taken if required) |
