INVITATION TO APPLY FOR THE SENTINEL PROGRAMME

OVERVIEW OF THE SENTINEL PROGRAMME

- 1. <u>Introduction</u>. The Sentinel Programme is a talent development programme that aims to develop our nation's cybersecurity talent pool by equipping youths with cybersecurity and digital skills. Organised by the Digital and Intelligence Service (DIS), in collaboration with the Defence Technology Community, the programme is fully sponsored by MINDEF/SAF.
- 2. <u>Programme Content</u>. The programme progressively equips students with cybersecurity and digital skills through workshops, classes and competitions. From 2026, students will also learn Artificial Intelligence (AI) concepts and applications in cybersecurity. Students will also have opportunities to learn about the cybersecurity profession in the defence sector through visits, mentorships and internships.
- 3. <u>Programme Structure</u>. Sentinel comprises a 4-year secondary programme and a 2-year post-secondary programme. Lower secondary students will attend holiday workshops, while upper secondary and post-secondary students will attend holiday workshops and fortnightly Saturday classes. The schedule of activities is provided at **Annex A**. Secondary school students who complete the secondary programme can continue with the post-secondary programme when they are in Pre-University education institutions, subject to meeting the qualifying criteria.

2026 SECONDARY 1 & PRE-UNIVERSITY 1 INTAKES

- 5. <u>Eligibility & Suitability</u>. The programme is open for application to **2026 Secondary 1** and **Pre-University 1 students (or equivalent)**, who are **Singaporeans or Singapore Permanent Residents**. Knowledge of programming is not required but will be useful.
- 6. <u>Application Process</u>. Interested students are invited to apply at go.gov.sg/sentinel using their school-assigned student email address (e.g., email addresses ending with @student.edu.sg). Students who do not have a valid school-assigned email address are to email us at sentinel@defence.gov.sg for further application instructions. All eligible applicants will be required to attempt an online selection test. The selection test is aptitude-based at the Secondary 1 level. At the Pre-University level, it will also assess basic programming skills. The test will also include a segment that requires applicants to submit a short video recording to introduce themselves. No preparation is required for the test.

2027 SECONDARY 3 INTAKE

- 8. <u>Eligibility & Suitability</u>. To cater to students who develop an interest in the digital/cybersecurity domain in the early secondary school years, the programme has introduced an additional intake for students to join the programme at Secondary 3. The next Secondary 3 intake (for 2027) is open for applications to 2026 Secondary 2 students. Only Singaporeans and Singapore Permanent Residents are eligible. Applicants with foundational knowledge in web development and computer networking are preferred.
- 9. <u>Application Process</u>. Interested students are invited to apply at go.gov.sg/sentinel. All applicants will be required to take a 2-hour online selection test. The test will assess basic knowledge on web development and computer networking, as well as aptitude in logical thinking and problem-solving. It will also include a submission of a short video recording for applicants to introduce themselves. Those who are selected will be required to complete a bridging workshop in December 2026, before joining the Secondary 3 cohort from January 2027.
