Here at West Spring, we strive to inculcate in students the values of **RICH - Resilience, Integrity, Care and Harmony**.

1. Update on Vice-Principal Appointment

We would like to inform parents of a change in our school leadership team. Our Vice-Principal (Administration), Mrs Joy Ong, has been posted to a new school. We would like to express our sincere appreciation for her dedicated service and valuable contributions to the school. We warmly welcome our new Vice-Principal, Mrs Toh Keting, who joins us with a wealth of experience and a strong commitment to supporting our students, staff and parents. We look forward to her leadership and partnership with our school community in the year ahead.

2. Reporting Time and Venues

Students are required to report to school daily by 7.20 am and be at the respective assembly venues by 7.25 am. Unless otherwise specified, students are to be in full school uniform. Students will report to the School Hall on the first day of school.

To support students' transition back to school, students will participate in school-based activities during the first three days of school, with an early dismissal at 12.30 pm on the following dates:

- Friday, 2 January 2026
- Monday, 5 January 2026
- Tuesday, 6 January 2026

From 07 January onwards, students will report to the School Hall on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays and in the form classrooms on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Dismissal time will be based on the students' timetable (effective from 7 Jan 2026), which will be available on the school website.



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On 08 January 2026, all Secondary 4 & 5 students will embark on a learning journey after curriculum time to **Ngee Ann Polytechnic Open House 2026 (1:30 pm - 3:30pm)**. Students will be dismissed from lessons for lunch at 11:55 am and a **one-way transport** will be provided from school to Ngee Ann Polytechnic. During the visit, students where we will have an opportunity to go on a guided tour to their selected Academic School and experience Ngee Ann Polytechnic CCA Xtra-vaganza. **Students will be dismissed at 3:30 pm at Ngee Ann Polytechnic.**

3. Blended Learning Schedule

As part of our Blended Learning approach, students will learn from home on **Fridays of even weeks (Semester 1 only)**, as indicated in their timetable.

In 2026 Semester 1, Secondary 4 & 5 students will be embarking on blended learning on selected even week Fridays. On the dates listed below, students will be studying from home and will not attend school physically. Students are expected to complete all work assigned on Blended Learning days. There will be a blended learning timetable disseminated that lists the academic periods and time allocated for students to follow.

5. School Lockers

Every student is provided with a locker in his/her Form Classroom free of charge. The student is expected to use a numeric lock for the locker. If the student does not have one, he/she can purchase from the school bookshop. Students are expected to lock up their mobile devices and Personal Learning Devices (PLD) when not in use during school hours. Students should bring home their PLD every day and not leave them in the lockers. The locker is the property of the school. Students are expected to take care of them and not damage or permanently personalise them.

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Please note that students who report sick during curriculum time will be sent home only if accompanied by parent/guardian.
