Secondary 4NA/NT Preliminary Examinations 2020

Please be informed that the Preliminary Examination will be conducted on **11 August - 20 August 2020**. A copy of your child's/ward's Preliminary Examination timetable is attached. There will be no lessons during the examination period.

Please note the dates and times of his/her papers as well as the following arrangements:

- 1. Your child will report to school as per normal and he/she will be dismissed from school after the last paper that he/she is sitting for each day. If the examination falls on a Monday, he/she will be expected to report straight to the examination venue by 7.20 am.
- If your child/ward is taking only the second paper for the day, he/she should report to school at least 20 minutes before the start of the paper.
- 3. If your child/ward is not sitting for any paper on a particular day and would like to report to school for consultations, he/she should **report to school by 8.00 am** in full school uniform.

We would appreciate your assistance in ensuring that your child/ward revises his/her work. Kindly note that 21 August is the marking day for the N level Preliminary Examination, your child/ward is not expected to report to school that day.

Attendance is compulsory. Pupils who are absent from any papers, must produce a medical certificate the following day without which, pupils will be deemed as absent without valid reason and no marks will be given for the examinations.
