Dear Parents/Guardians of Secondary 2 students

BACK TO SCHOOL IN TERM 2

A warm welcome back to all Secondary 2 students and parents!

This letter provides you with the key changes and overview of the school/level activities for your child for Term 2. The content of this letter can also be found on our school website at <https://www.westspringsec.moe.edu.sg>.

As 23 March (Monday) is a school holiday (off-in-lieu for Hari Raya Puasa), we will welcome our students back on 24 March (Tuesday) in the school hall for morning assembly. Grooming and attire checks will be conducted on the first day of school. We seek your support in ensuring your child comply with the school's grooming and attire guidelines.

In view of the warm weather, students may attend school in either full school uniform or half uniform. Half uniform consists of the school PE T-shirt with school pants or skirts. Students who wish to wear jackets must be in full school uniform. Jackets cannot be worn over PE T-shirts. Parents are kindly reminded to ensure your child remain appropriately dressed in accordance with the school's grooming and attire guidelines sent earlier via PG.

1. Morning Assembly Routines

From Term 2 onwards, we will be adjusting classroom access timings to better support student punctuality and supervision before morning assembly.

A. New Classroom Schedule

Classrooms will be locked daily from 5.00 p.m. onwards and unlocked according to the following schedule:

- **Monday, Wednesday and Friday:** 7.40 a.m. to 7.50 a.m.
- **Tuesday and Thursday:** 6.55 a.m. to 7.10 a.m.

Students who arrive early are welcome to use the canteen area for revision or socialising before proceeding to the assembly venue. For those who prefer a quieter environment, study spaces outside the staffroom are also available. Please note that like classrooms, these study areas are designated as no-food zones.

B. Updated Mobile Device Procedures

These timing changes will also affect mobile device storage:

- **Lower Secondary students:** Devices will be locked in Learning Group (LG) lockers during the first LG lesson. If the first lesson is not LG, devices must remain switched off and kept in their bags until the first LG lesson.
- **Upper Secondary students:** Devices will be locked in class lockers during the first lesson of the day.

These adjustments aim to encourage punctual reporting to assembly, reduce unsupervised classroom time, and strengthen our school routines. We appreciate your support in helping students adapt to these new procedures. Should you have any questions, please contact the school office.

B. Blended Learning Changes

Please note that our Blended Learning subject arrangements for Term 2 are different from Term 1. In view of the holidays that fall on Friday in Term 2, the Blended Learning Days in Term 2 will be on **17 Apr, 15 May and 29 May**.

C. School Dismissal Times

All students must **remain on school** premises until the designated dismissal times listed below, even if their individual classes end earlier:

- Monday to Wednesday: 1:05 p.m.
- Thursday: 2:50 p.m.
- Friday: 12:30 p.m.

We appreciate your support in ensuring your child adheres to these dismissal times.

Importance of Punctuality and Active Engagement in Lessons
