

# Q&A

Q: How is the new L1R4 system affects this batch of students born in 2011? Are they going to take 1 subject lesser compare to the previous batch?

A: New L1R4 means students only require 5 subjects. Bonus points is reduced from 4 to 3. To qualify for JC, the L1R4 is capped at 16 points.

In our school, the number of subjects will be the same.

Q: Will the school be offering literature?

A: No.



# Q&A

- 1) Is POA applicable with 2 pure Sciences?
- A: No.
- 2) Under what circumstances, will the child have to take Art subject?

A: If the student is not choosing Pure Sciences and decides not to take Pure Geography, the student will be taking Art.

- 3) Is POA applicable with A and E Math?
- A: It depends on which combination the student choose.
- 4) Will limitation to 2 sciences limit their JC opportunities and consequently university courses?
- A: No.



#### Examples of 'A' level Subject Pre-requisites for NUS Science courses

Courses	Subject Pre-requisites
Dentistry	H2 pass in Chemistry and either Biology or Physics
Food Science and Technology	H2 pass in any two of the following: - Chemistry, Biology, Physics, Computing
Medicine	H2 pass in Chemistry and either Biology or Physics
Nursing	H2 pass in any two of the following: - Biology, Chemistry, Computing, Physics and Mathematics
Pharmacy	Very good pass in H2 Chemistry and very good pass in H2 Biology, Physics, Mathematics or Further Mathematics
Pharmaceutical Science	Very good pass in H2 Chemistry and very good pass in H2 Biology, Physics, Mathematics or Further Mathematics
