

Singapore-Cambridge Secondary Education Certificate (SEC) Examinations

- From 2027, graduating students will sit for the Singapore-Cambridge Secondary Education Certificate (SEC) examinations, at their respective subject levels (i.e. G1, G2, G3).
- No change to the examination format
- SEC Examination Timetable

 Sept - Written examinations for English Language and Mother Tongue Languages

- Oct-Nov 1 common exam period for rest of the subjects
- Only 1 written examination sitting for all MTL subject levels (i.e. G1, G2, G3 MTL and G3 Higher MTL).
- 1 common result release held in January of the following year





Post-secondary Pathways for G1 Students (FSBB)





Eligibility for 5th Year

- 5th year of secondary education allows eligible students to pace their learning and possibly offer subjects at a more demanding level to access more post-secondary pathways.
- ELMAB3, computed at G2, is used to determine students' eligibility for the 5th year.

Harmonised criteria to access 5th year

- If 3 or more G3 Passes, must not qualify for JC/MI/Poly Y1
- If 2 or fewer G3 Passes, must attain raw ELMAB3 ≤ 21¹, ELB3¹ ≤ 14 or MAB3¹ ≤ 14

1: At least Grade 5 at G2 for all subjects used in computation of aggregate

Student profile	Subject level for subjects taken in 5 th year	
Sec 4 students offering mostly G2 subjects, progressing to 5 th year to offer mostly G3 subjects	Can upgrade all subjects to G3 if raw ELMAB3 ≤ 19


